In accordance with Article VI, Section 61.1 of the Bylaws of the Harvard Undergraduate Council, find here proposed the budget for the Fiscal Year covering the 2015-2016 Academic Year:

Whereas Article V, Section 2 and Article V, Section 3 of the Constitution of the Harvard Undergraduate Council imposes certain statutory limitations on the Budget;

Be it further resolved that the Chair of the Finance Committee notify each recipient listed below of the decision of the Undergraduate Council regarding their grant application within 24 hours of this bill's passage, and provide each recipient with all necessary information for obtaining the funds allocated herein.
