1. At the General Meeting, a representative proposed an amendment that would have changed the funding source from the Operations Fund to the SIC Fund. Due to a successful tabling motion, this amendment was never voted upon.
 - a. During debate of the aforementioned amendment (1), a motion was made to table the legislation. This motion failed by hand vote, 14 – 22 – 1.
 - b. During debate of the aforementioned amendment (1), a motion was made to table the legislation. This motion passed by roll call vote, 26 – 9 – 2. The ballots of this vote are recorded above.
