

➤ **35S-22: A Bylaws Amendment Requiring Automatic Recesses Before Roll Call Votes**

- According to Robert's Rules of Order: If someone calls for a recess, you actually always get a recess.
- Q&A
 - Why do you think this is necessary?
 - Sometimes pro-con debate isn't always the correct manner to address someone's questions / concerns
 - Want every council member to vote individually
 - Not to waste pro-con debate time to address a more individual discussion
 - We haven't been operating in a consistent manner with recesses
 - If there's a substantial minority of Council that is overruled by the 2/3rds bylaws vote, they aren't getting the chance to be able to address thoughts and questions to each other
- Pro-Con debate
 - Pro
 - This is more like a full minority "protection"
 - This barrier for a roll call vote is good for important issues
- Bylaws amendment -- 2/3rds majority vote
 - Motion for a hand vote
 - 3 oppositions - no abstentions
 - **35S-22 passes by 2/3rds majority through hand vote.**

➤ **35S-23: An Amendment to Require Sexual Assault Prevention Training**

- Purpose: To correct problem that we had last week
- PBHA's student officers, HoCo members are required to go through FiCom's sexual assault bystander prevention training
- This amendment guarantees FiCom to have the authority to do this / change funding for these groups
- Amend constitution as narrowly as possible so we aren't granted more power
- Q&A
 - Assuming retention / turnover of HoCo / PBHA members?
 - This is just the broad authorization for FiCom to authorize this!
 - Give ourselves the authority to regulate the PBHA and HoCo's funding

- UC gains no additional authority to regulate funding
 - The UC shall give no less than \$30,000 to PBHA each year; the UC shall give no less than \$4k to each HoCo per year.
 - Provision: If we have a logistical screw up on our end, we reserve the right to get rid of funding completely
 - Did we talk to HoCo or PBHA about this?
 - Yes
 - Move to pass bylaws amendment through hand vote
 - **35S-23 passes unanimously through hand vote.**
- *Move to remove last week's legislation (35S-18) from the table*
 - *Unanimously passes through voice vote.*
- **35S-18**
 - Pro-Con debate
 - Move to go into 2 minute recess to remind themselves what the legislation was about and read over this
 - 1/3rd hand vote
 - Passes
 - Declare another 1 min recess
 - Passes by voice vote
 - Cons for entire legislation?
 - None
 - Move to voting
 - **35S-18 unanimously passes through voice vote.**
- **35S-24**
 - \$40,000 this week
 - Q&A
 - School of Rock?
 - Jam out to rock music in Mather
 - Were there any cuts this week?
 - Try to keep cuts below 15%
 - EMT class uniforms
 - Are there new forms each week?
 - We are allowed to allocate money for uniforms and supplies
 - Does this cut stay standard for the rest of the semester?
 - They wanted accommodations for hotel and speakers which we just do not fund

- Pro-Con debate
 - None
- Move to unanimous consent
 - **35S-24 passes through unanimous consent.**

➤ **GoHC Grants Pack Legislation**

- Veritas Forum
- Peer counseling group meals: Important to have training and not request members to pay out of their pockets
- Q&A
 - Yaz and Cam comments about peer counseling group meals:
 - Peer counseling for opening days has always been coming from UHS, but UHS has been going under budget constraints recently
 - First time they haven't been funding peer counseling groups' meals
 - Peer counseling groups are currently trying to get funding from the Administration
 - Yaz and Cam are trying to work out deals with El Jefe's, etc. to get entire meals funded for \$500
 - Veritas Forum?
 - Group of interfaith people on campus
 - Bring professors from Harvard + MIT to come speak
 - AV costs, food in CQH
 - Location: Science Center B
 - Travel costs are excluded
 - Happening on April 19th
- Pro-Con debate
 - Con
 - \$2000 for peer counseling group meals? College should not be getting funding from our undergraduates for this.
 - Veritas Forum is on a Thursday night, same week as Yardfest, Visitas, and Eleganza.
 - Pro
 - Reality is, they're not getting meals for this time period, so either way we should fund them.
 - Veritas Forum is trying to bring together 10-15 different student groups on campus!
- Move to unanimous consent

- **GoHC Grants Pack legislation passes through unanimous consent.**

- 10 minute recess (come back at 8:15pm)
 - (New business always comes at the end of the meeting)
- **Q&A with Dean Khurana and Dean Dingman on First-Year Bridge Program (find notes here)**
- 5 minute recess
- **New Business**
 - Freshman year is filled with excitement, confusion, etc.
 - This event will “close out” freshman year
 - Addresses mental health and other issues
 - Each day will have a specific theme
 - Right now just want to fund the swag
 - \$1,700 total funding
 - Well being, diversity, etc.: Different themes each day
 - Vote to consider this new business
 - Passes through unanimous voice vote
 - Q&A
 - Breakdown of funding?
 - Just asking for funding for the swag
 - Will still have \$540 left -- last big bang for FCC
 - Why was this presented as new business?
 - Timing -- needed extra time to customize swag items
 - Yoga swag not included
 - Civic engagement day?
 - Pro-Con debate
 - Con
 - In the future, let’s make sure that new business only when it’s absolutely necessary
 - The issue was not with Grace and Nadine; the rest of FCC did not get back to them as fast as they should have
 - Civic engagement day
 - Phoning congressmen?
 - Will be more tailored next week when breakdown of events is announced
 - Pro

- New Business not good because can't be vetted by FCC first, but here FCC did vett it first
- Move to voice vote
 - **Passes unanimously through voice vote**
